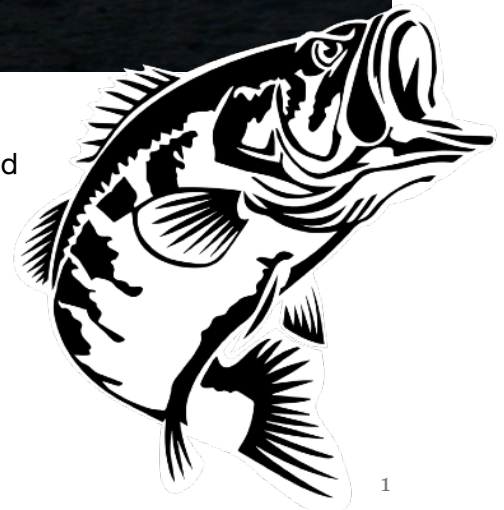

"MANITOULIN ISLAND provides, for most boys and girls, a first opportunity to really catch fish. It may seem unusual to go to an island to fish, but the Manitoulin is no ordinary island. It is the largest freshwater island in the world, located in Lake Huron, about 560 km north of Toronto. The island is beautifully located with its outcrops of limestone and cedar, beech and maple trees. It has a number of lakes, Big Lake, Lake Manitou and Mindemoya Lake - in all over 100! The Island was named by the Ojibways and means, "the Great God Manitou", "Manitou" means "Great Spirit."

THE FEAST OF BOOTHS

Weeks at Manitoulin have some similarities to the Jewish feast of booths, celebrated in the seventh month of the Hebrew calendar. At this feast, Israelites were commanded to gather branches and build temporary booths on the roofs of their houses, in the temple courts and in the streets. They were to sleep and eat in these booths for one week and remember the wilderness journey, where Israel left their homes in Egypt and camped in the wilderness.

This feast was a great equalizer, as everyone, rich or poor, would go without the comforts of their home. They would sleep under starry skies and cook meals over open fires. In the time of Nehemiah, this feast was renewed, and “there was very great **GLADNESS**”.
